

# **CLUB REGULATIONS FOR VISITORS**

Welcome to Island Yacht Club. To ensure the full enjoyment of the Club, all Guests using the facilities shall abide by the Club Rules and Regulations.

Guests using the Club facilities do so entirely at their own risk. The Club shall not be responsible for any loss or damage to the person or property of any Member, or of his or her family or Guests, however caused.

Club Management is authorized to restrict or control the behavior of Guests, when such behaviour is contrary to the Rules and Regulations of the Club or interferes with the enjoyment of the Club by others, including if necessary, ensuring that such persons leave Club property.

# **Harassment, Bullying & Discrimination**

Island Yacht Club is committed to maintaining an environment that is free of harassment in order for our members, guests, and employees to feel safe.

Intimidation, humiliation, and/or sabotaging others will not be tolerated. Also prohibited is the wilful discrimination based on age, sexual orientation, ethnicity, race, religion, or disability.

Any allegation of harassment, bullying and/or discrimination will be thoroughly investigated and where appropriate will be dealt with under the disciplinary procedure.

# **Damage to Club Property**

Damage to Club property, however caused by a Guest, shall be paid for by the responsible Guest in an amount determined by Club Management.

While visiting, we request that you observe the following:

## **Club House, Dining & Alcohol Consumption**

- > The regulations of the Liquor License Act of Ontario shall be strictly adhered to at all times. This means among other things that:
  - (a) The serving and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be confined to licensed areas only and to the times authorized in the AGCO license; and
  - (b) No alcoholic beverages shall be permitted in the clubhouse or on the patio or tent or pool area when the bars are closed.
- Consumption of personal alcohol is permitted on personal vessels and in designated north and south picnic areas only
- No personal food or beverages may be consumed in the pool area
- BBQ'ing is not permitted on vessels. BBQ'ing is only permitted in designated areas. Club BBQ's are provided in the north and south picnic areas and are clearly marked
- Proper attire is required when using the Club House. Shirts (sleeved for males) and shoes are to be worn at all times, including to and from the pool area

#### **BBQ & Picnic Areas**

- Barbecues are not to be used on any boat while docked at the Club. Barbecues and cooking of any kind is strictly prohibited on any of the docks.
- Designated Club BBQ's are located to the north and south ends of the Club grounds and are marked IYC.
- Guests are expected to clean up BBQ and BBQ area after cooking.
- ➤ Picnic tables, grills and fire pits cannot be reserved and are to be shared by all. Please be considerate of others. Tablecloths are not allowed to be left overnight to "reserve" a spot for the next day, or placed in the morning and left unused until an evening event
- Any Club property should be returned to its proper location after use. i.e. kayaks, canoes, toys, games, water containers belonging to the Club House, etc
- Open fires are only permitted in the Club fire pits.

## Smoking/Vaping

> Smoking and/or vaping is not permitted in any of the Club buildings or on any of its outside decks, docks, pool, BBQ, or tennis court areas. In accordance with City of Toronto by-laws, no person shall smoke or vape within a nine-metre radius of any Club building. Smoking is only permitted on your vessel

# Pets

- Pets are not permitted in or around the Clubhouse, tennis courts, decks, or pool areas at any time. Upon arrival at the Club, pets are to be confined to the Guest's boat for the duration of their stay, provided that they may be exercised in the marine yard area or walked on a leash along the waterfront or nature walking trails. All pets must always be leashed and accompanied by Guests. Pets may not be left unattended, attached to trees or other objects at any time.
- Guests are fully responsible for any damage caused by their pets. Pet owners shall be responsible for the immediate removal and disposal in proper containers of any excrement from their pets. The Club Management shall have full authority to expel any pet from the premises.
- Service animals are permitted with proper documentation.

#### Noise

Noise shall be kept to a minimum at all times. All persons shall exercise discretion when hosting gatherings on their vessels and/or operating generators, engines, radios, etc. to ensure fellow boaters are not disturbed. A strict noise curfew is enforced after 11:00 p.m.

# **Tennis & PickleBall Courts**

- Guests shall abide by the Tennis & PickleBall Court Rules as posted
- Proper tennis shoes are required when using the courts

#### **Pool Regulations**

- Guests are required to obey Swimming Pool Rules as posted
- ➤ Large floatables or water guns are not permitted in the pool or on the pool deck
- When there is a Lifeguard(s) on duty, the Lifeguard(s) shall be in charge of overseeing the swimming pool and pool area. Guests shall, at all times, comply with any requests, orders, or instructions that the Lifeguard(s) may make for the purpose of ensuring the safety of persons in the swimming pool area. The Lifeguard(s) shall have the right to remove any person or persons from the swimming pool or swimming pool area at his/her sole discretion.
- If a Lifeguard is not present, use of the pool is at one's own risk, as per pool signage
- Children under 12 years of age will only be permitted in the Pool and Pool area if accompanied and supervised by a parent or guardian 18 years of age or over
- Children, who are not toilet trained, or who are in diapers are not allowed in the swimming pool. Children in swim diapers are permitted in the pool.
- > Glassware is strictly prohibited in and around the pool area
- Consumption of personal food and/or beverages is prohibited in and around the pool area.
- Lounge chairs and sitting areas are available on a first come first serve basis. As a courtesy to others, Guests are asked not to reserve seating and to remove belongings when leaving the pool area.

# **Harbour Swimming Regulations**

- Swimming is not permitted from boats or from any docks within the Club.
- Any swimming in the Harbour is at the Guests own risk. All Guests are strongly advised of the possibility of electrical currents being discharged in the water in or around the Club which can cause death

#### Guests

Visiting boaters are not permitted to have guests while visiting the Club.

#### Moorings

- Guests shall at all times be considerate of others. Guests shall not operate equipment on their boats that may make objectionable noises or emit offensive odors or fumes, which might offend or disturb occupants of neighboring boats. Boats and the surrounding dock shall be maintained in a neat and orderly fashion.
- Guests shall not store dinghies, kayaks, or other watercraft, or devices, on the docks. These items must be stored on the guest's boat, in the water or at a designated location.

#### **Boarding**

No Guest shall board another boat without the owner's permission, unless required for reasons of safety or the protection of the boat.

### **Speed Limit**

A maximum speed limit of 6 miles per hour (4.8 knots) shall be observed in the waterways around the Club. All boats shall be operated in a safe and courteous manner and shall not leave any wake that may disturb or threaten any docked or moored boats. Canada Shipping Act and Ports Toronto regulations shall be observed at all times.

#### Waste & Garbage

- Garbage, hazardous, noxious or similar substances of waste shall not be disposed of overboard or left on the docks or grounds. All waste shall be recycled or disposed of in garbage and recycling containers placed throughout the Club grounds and facilities.
- No person shall discharge oil, diesel fuel, gasoline, flammable liquids, ethylene glycol, oily bilge water or any other environmentally hazardous substances anywhere on IYC lands or water.
- Fueling from portable containers within IYC is strictly prohibited. Storage of fuel or fuel containers on or near docks is a serious safety violation and is strictly prohibited.
- > Toilets and holding tanks are not to be emptied on IYC property except by use of proper pumpout facilities.
