

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

As of March 2022

With the Province of Ontario's recent changes to COVID-19 mandates and protocols, the Island Yacht Club will be lifting its mandatory vaccination policy for members, staff, contractors, and guests effective March 1, 2022. Members, staff, contractors, and/or guests will not be required to register to board the tender, nor will they be required to complete the COVID-19 waiver prior to boarding the tender or coming to the Club.

This decision is consistent in following and abiding by the various mandates and regulations as outlined by the Province of Ontario as well as the applicable health authorities. Blockhouse Bay Management, along with the Island Yacht Club's Board of Directors, will continue to monitor and follow the governments, and health authorities, regulations based on the course of COVID-19, including the possibility that the Province of Ontario, or the Federal Government, may choose to reintroduce the vaccination policy once again at a later date.

The Island Yacht Club will continue to abide by governmental, and related health authority, recommendations to be vaccinated against COVID-19. While our government's announcement to lift the vaccination policy is both positive and encouraging, we do need to be reminded that the pandemic is not over, and we must remain vigilant. Please refrain from coming to the Club if you are feeling unwell or exhibit any COVID-19 related symptoms.
